

Make things easy for yourself by setting up your bimonthly payment as an automatic deduction from your bank account.

To start, visit www.camanowater.com, click **Forms & Publications**, and then click **Automatic Payment Plan Application**. Or, call the CWA office at (360) 387-9136 to request the application.

After your Automatic Payment Plan Application is processed, you will continue to receive a bill showing current charges. The bill will include the note "Do Not Pay – Automatic Payment." The payment transaction is done on the 20th of each billing month.





From water rights to wells to water treatment and beyond



It takes more than pumping water out of the ground to get ample, good-quality water flowing through the faucets in your home.

To be sure, it starts with water rights and wells. Camano Water Association has eight wells to serve the members in the Country Club area. The water system also includes a sophisticated treatment plant to ensure the water meets the highest levels of quality in accordance with Washington State Department of Health standards and regulations.

From there, the distribution system — including storage tanks, pressure reduction valves, hydrants, and meters — delivers the water to your property.

But the story doesn't end there. The system must be properly maintained, and safety and security ensured. The company must also handle budgets, billing, and banking in a responsible manner.
